Adding to its capability are features like the oil pressure sensing system and the remarkable Engine Braking Reduction System (E.B.R.S.).

### All-new chassis - low weight with high strength

Our latest chassis, specially developed for the SRViper Mountain series, features aluminium construction with a load-bearing, triangulated design that helps keep weight low and strength high. The result is razor-sharp agility and a superbly balanced ride, with the dynamics to complement a huge variety of riding styles.



### A riding position tuned to the mountains

The short, high seat, tapered towards the front, works together with the tall riser handlebar position - with mountain strap - to give you great comfort and control over the agile chassis. Easy counter steering on steep sidehills comes naturally too, thanks to the handlebar's flat turning arc provided by the vertical steering post.

### Asymmetric front suspension and narrow ski stance

An outstanding characteristic of all our new SRViper models is the unique suspension design and ski geometry. For the front of the M-TX 153 SE we've chosen FOX® FLOAT® 3 shocks, which deliver ultra-responsive handling - yet with the strength to handle the demands of this machine's natural mountain and backcountry habitat.



### Dual Shock SR 153 rear suspension

The SRViper M-TX gives you an impressive range of easily adjustable pressure and tuning options, thanks to its FOX® FLOAT® 2 and aluminium HPG shocks. What's more, the special springless suspension developed for these models has been designed to reduce the amount (and weight) of built-up snow, to give you better stability and control.

### Camoplast® Power Claw 2.6"/66mm track

A stunning performer in all conditions, the Camoplast® Power Claw track chosen for our M-TX SRVipers features 2.6 inch (66 mm) lugs. The track is driven by extrovert drive sprockets which mesh precisely with holes in the track, acting like a gear mechanism to deliver outstanding levels of grip and propulsion, particularly in deep snow.
